



EXPOSÉ

The lively and festive programme 'A Brassy Christmas Journey' will get you into the Christmas spirit. Embark on a unique Christmas journey with the five young musicians of Karidion Brass. In the first half of the concert, the trumpets in particular take over the virtuoso part of the violins or the recorder in masterpieces by George Frideric Handel, John Baston and Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. Works by Johannes Brahms and Pietro Mascagni stand in stark contrast to the playful virtuosity. While the first half of the programme is dominated by classical works, in the second half the musicians of Karidion Brass show the full range of their repertoire with predominantly new arrangements of American Christmas carols in all styles from salsa to jazz.
