If you have ever dreamed of being a king or being treated like one, then the Christmas concert 'Un Noël royal festif' is just the thing for you. In the first half of the concert, Karidion Brass devotes itself exclusively to baroque music at the French courts. In compositions by Jean-Baptiste Lully, Jean-Philippe Rameau and M. R. Delalande, you will not only experience the sounds of royal trumpets, but also the multifaceted richness of the tuba through alternating imitations of timpani and violone. After the interval, it finally gets Christmassy and you will experience a fitting selection of the best-known German and French Christmas carols in arrangements specially written for Karidion Brass. You can look forward to

pieces such as 'Leise rieselt der Schnee' or 'Il est né, le devin enfant'. At the end of the concert, a jazzy Christmas carol medley by Ingo Luis will send you off into the festive season.

DURATION

The first half lasts approx. 30 minutes, the second half 45 minutes including encores.
