

FROM OPERA TO BROADWAY

EXPOSÉ

When it says 'Curtain up for Karidion Brass', then you are in the concert programme 'From Opera to Broadway'. The magnificent overture from George Frideric Handel's baroque opera 'Rinaldo' welcomes you in the first half of the concert. This is followed by two arias by the composers Antonín Dvořák and Ludwig van Beethoven, in which each of the five musicians takes on the role of an opera singer. Excerpts from Richard Strauss' opera "Der Rosenkavalier" and the famous drinking song from Giuseppe Verdi's "La Traviata" will send you off into the interval. If you are wondering how you suddenly ended up at Lake Wolfgang in Austria, you will be greeted with the sounds of Ralph Benatzky's 'Im weißen Rössl' in the second half of the concert. The lively programme continues with music from 'My fair Lady' and the Yiddish musical 'Men ken leb'n nor men lost nisht'. The grand finale features music from the world-famous musical 'West Side Story', written by L. Bernstein and arranged by Ingo Luis.
